SECOND AMENDED ANSWER	

Alice Kim (“Kim”) and U.S. ABCfield, Inc. (collectively “Defendants”), by and through counsel, Alex and Associates, P.C., admit, deny and aver as follows:

ANSWER TO GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

1. As to the allegations in paragraph 1, Defendants are without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth or falsity of said allegations and therefore deny the same.
2. As to the allegations in paragraph 2, Kim admits she is an individual who resides in Denver. Kim admits she is the sole shareholder and owner of U.S. ABCfield, Inc., a Colorado corporation. Defendants admit U.S. ABCfield operates and does business as Daily Idea. Defendants admit Daily Idea is a weekly Asian language publication. Kim writes for the Daily Idea. 3. Defendants agree venue is proper in Arapahoe County.
4. As to the allegations in paragraph 4, Defendants admit that an article was published in the Daily Idea newspaper on June 24, 2019. As the newspaper is published in the Asian Language, Defendants deny the article was entitled, “Legal battle between former branch presidents of Asian Daily Denver.” Defendants deny any and all allegations associated with or relating to what is termed as “Article 1.”
