This document describes the changes made in ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 Release 2 Update 8.

About the product

ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 is a new version of the FlexiCapture product, whose main goal is to provide a stable and scalable Data Capture platform that can serve as a basis for creating regional and vertical solutions.

About the update

The update includes new features and bug fixes. It can be installed on its own or on top of ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 Release 1 or Release 2 with any updates installed.

New functionality

1. Full self-service scenario on Web Verification Station: new filter for manual data export on local machine

For the manual data export scenario, a new filter has been added to the filter drop-down list in batch view. This filter shows batches that have never been downloaded.

This filter is disabled by default. To enable it, use the CanDownloadBatchResult key in the web.config file (the default location of the web.config file is inetpub\wwwroot\FlexiCapture12\Verification on each web station).

Bug Fixes

Issue description

FlexiCapture Standalone. Automatic import from "hot folders" stops if any error occurs and the administrator has to resume it manually. This leads to unnecessary manual effort and the administrator's intervention even in the event of occasional harmless network errors. Now a Windows registry key is available that prevents automatic import from stopping even when errors occur.

To prevent import from stopping, set the Windows registry key

"HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\ABBYY\FlexiCapture\12.0\Shell\Import\ContinueAutoImportDespite Errors" to "true".

By default, this key is set to "false" (i.e. import will stop on errors).

When a scripting processing stage failed due to an unhandled exception in the user code, there was no message in the processing notes for the document. Now, processing notes contain an error message.

In some rare cases, the Project Setup Station crashed when trying to upload onto the server a project updated to the latest version. Now uploads successfully without crashing.

The priority was not correctly defined (one level lower than it should be) when sending a new batch from the Web or Desktop Scanning Station. Now it defines correctly.

Licence Manager: On a system with the EN user interface, the "Expiration Date" value was in RU (Russian).

Fixed an error caused by inputting Japanese text using Microsoft's Japanese IME on the Web Verification Station. After a spelling variant selected from the list of suggestions was confirmed, the cursor position was reset to the beginning of the field, and the spaces disappeared.

An installed Remote Scanning Station could not be started because some of the files were missing in the Scanning Station installation package.

The "Dates" element in FlexiLayout Studio did not work for dates in Ukrainian.
