Main features

Compatibility with BluePrism version 7.2

Starting from this version, the connector is compatible with Blue Prism version 7.2.

If you want to use Blue Prism version 7.2, be sure to update your ABBYY Vantage Connector for Blue Prism to the latest version and reconfigure the existing processes to use the new SaveTransactionResult action. The GetTransactionResult action will work with earlier versions of Blue Prism up to version 7.2. For detailed instructions, see the Updating the connector section in the ABBYY Vantage Connector for Blue Prism User Guide.

Server-to-server authentication scheme

A new authentication flow called Client Credentials, which is suitable for server-to-server communications, is now supported in the Vantage API. This flow is designed for cases when there is an application that allows end-users to process documents using Vantage without having accounts in Vantage.

The new flow can be enabled for any tenant's API client. When enabling the flow, the tenant administrator can assign roles that will be granted to the application that connects to Vantage using this flow. When connecting to Vantage, the application will get an access token with the roles specified in the client's API settings.

This flow is recommended for situations where an external identity provider is enabled for the tenant, allowing for authentication in Vantage even when the Authorization Code flow would not be suitable.
